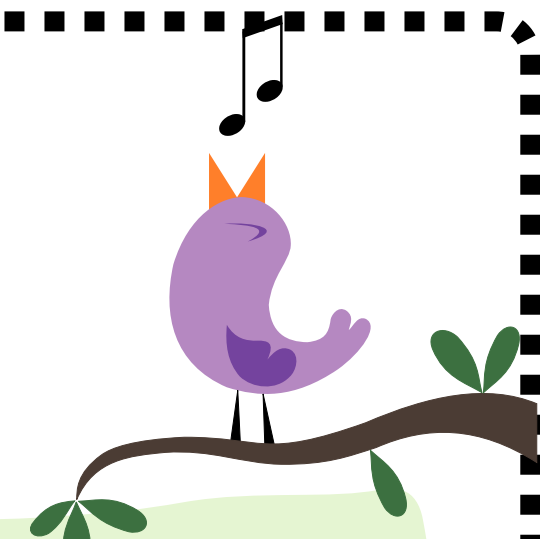


ECO NEWSLETTER
