Menu of ideas:

- Create a fact file about a hot or cold place of your choice. Where is it in the world? What might you wear there? What animals might you find there?
- Explore the human and physical geography of a local area, e.g. garden, park or nature reserve etc... Consider what is man-made and what is natural.
- The United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries. Research a chosen country. What does the flag look like? What is their national flower? Traditional foods?
- Create an observation drawing showing the environment in autumn. You can do this in your garden, at a park or a place of your choice. Make sure to look carefully at the colours of the leaves.
- Go on an autumn themed sensory walk. What can you hear? See? Smell? Touch? Use adjectives to describe your journey.
- Create a piece of art using leaves, mud, twigs, stones or anything else you can find in the environment.
