Menu of ideas:

- Research an artist with a grown up and create a fact file to present to the class. You could recreate a piece of their artwork using pencils, paint or pastels. Need an idea? You might look at Jasper Johns in more detail after we created number paintings in school using the three primary colours.





-Practise playing or singing along to your favourite song. Why not make a video of your performance, or you could perform to the class.

- While listening to some music, draw and write about what you can hear, what it makes you imagine and how it makes you feel. You could choose some music from a film, or ask a grown up to help you choose a song. Why not rate it from 0 - 10.



- Create an observation drawing showing the environment in Spring. You can do this in your garden, at a park or a place of your choice. Make sure to look carefully at all of the details.

If your child has any other ideas, that is great, we would love to see their creativity.
