



FRENCH - UNIT 4 - In a French classroom

In this unit of French, we will be introduced to the imperative mood and start to learn some classroom instruction words. We will be introduced to the idea of noun gender and the different forms of the article (un/une) to identify the gender of a noun. We will learn to respond to and give out simple instructions, learn and use vocabulary for items commonly found in a school bag, and we will begin to form simple sentences using 'I have' or 'I don't have'. We will learn and start to use some simple conjunctions, 'and' and 'but'. At the end of this unit, we will be writing short sentences using all of the descriptive vocabulary that we have already learned to describe items on our school bag.
