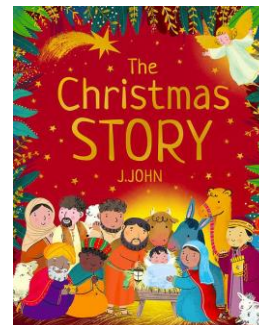
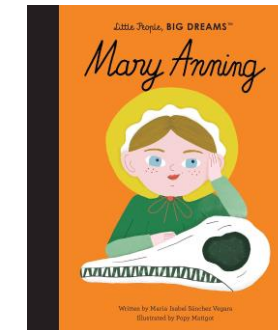
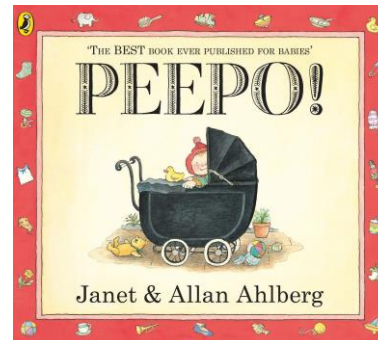
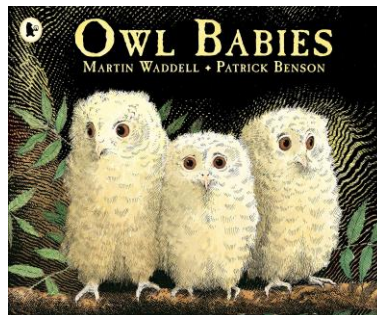
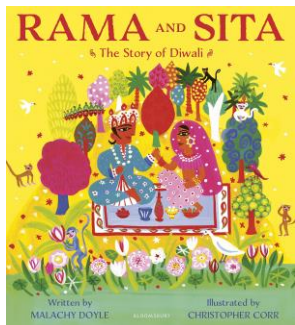
## Sticky Knowledge
