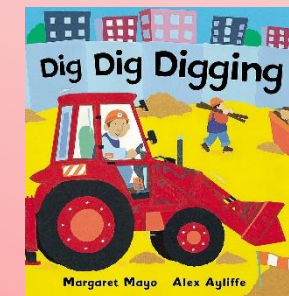
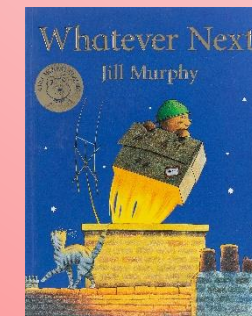
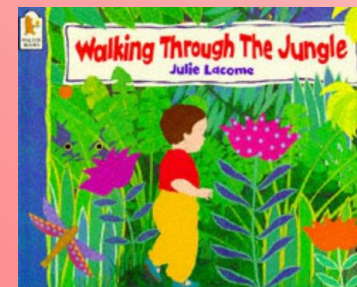
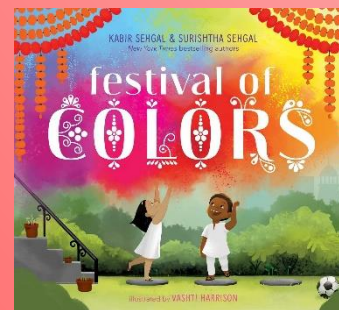
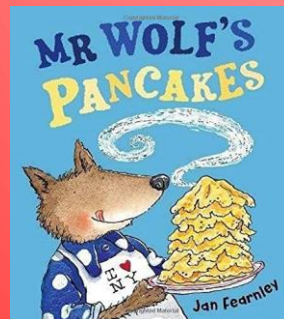
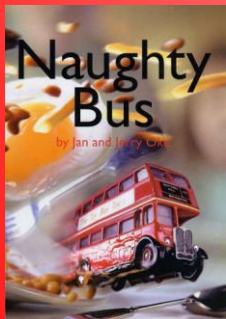
- I know what rules are and why we have to follow them.
