Vocabulary	Definition
Imagination	The ability of the mind to be creative and resourceful to form new idea and concepts.
Creativity	the use of imagination or original ideas to create something;
Pattern	A pattern is a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated
Texture	Texture refers to the surface quality in a work of art.
Shape	Shape is a flat area surrounded by edges or an outline.
Form	An element of shape or what the final piece looks like.
Materials	anything an artist uses to create art in any combination.
Tones	lightness or darkness of a colour
Tints	where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour.
Shades	where an artist adds black to a colour to darken it down.
Forms of Art	Naturalism, Surrealism, Street Art, Pop Art, Modern, Expressionism, Portrait, Landscape
