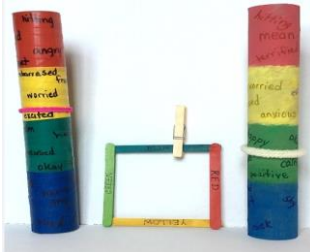


This "Pick and Mix" homework is for the whole half term.
