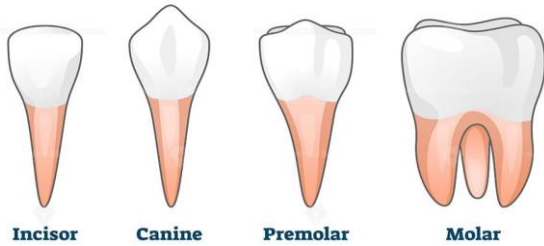
We have been blown away by the creations and models that we have seen so far as part of the Pick 'n Mix homework and look forward to seeing where else the project takes the children!

## TYPES OF TEETH

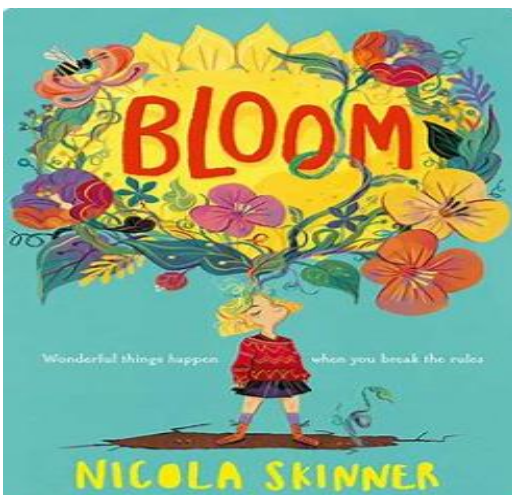


Year 4 have enjoyed our topic in science this term (animals including humans) and have learnt about the digestive system and teeth.
