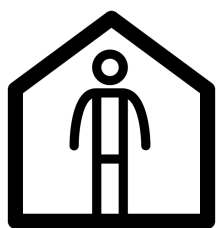


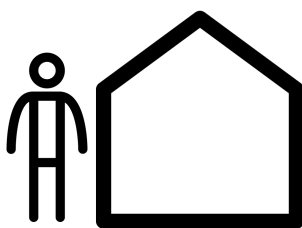


Prepositions

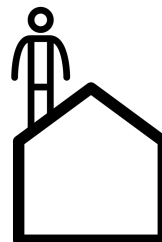
Prepositions shows the relation between a noun or a pronoun in relation to another element of a sentence.



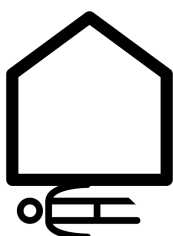

Beside



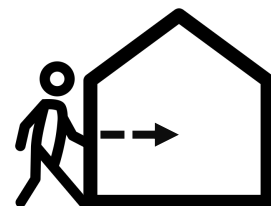

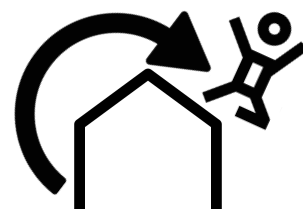

Sometimes tells the reader where or when something is in relation to something else. This is usually one **noun** compared to another e.g. *The cup is **on** the table.*

Some prepositions aren't as obvious so **DON'T** forget these.
