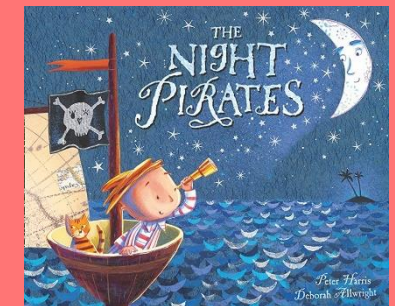
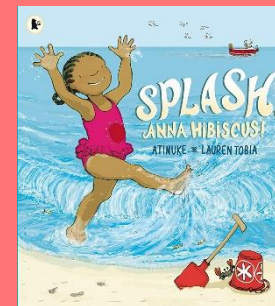
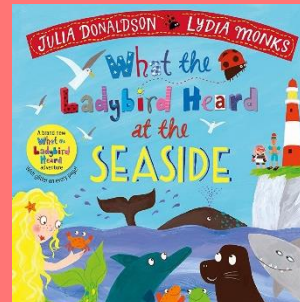
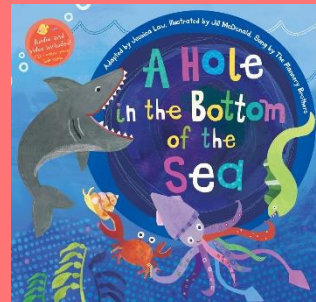
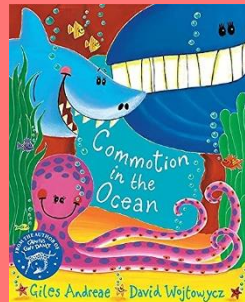
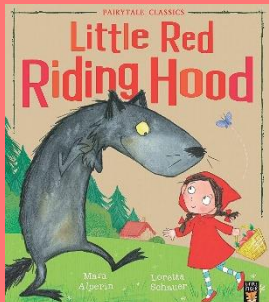
## Sticky Knowledge
