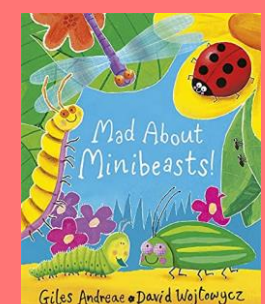
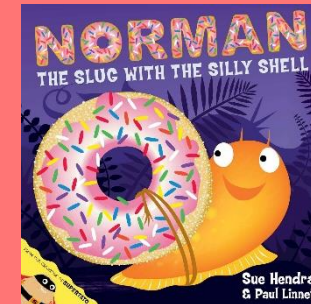
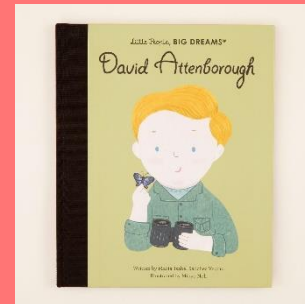
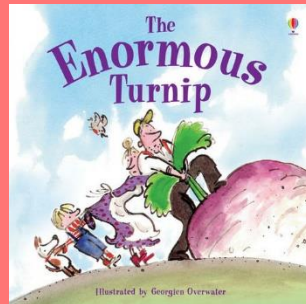
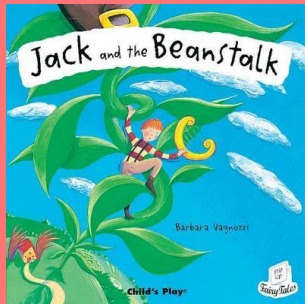
Sticky Knowledge
