Artist or Musician Research Project

Research an artist or musician of your choice and present your findings to share with the class. You could write a biography, create a PowerPoint or design a poster to share what you have learnt.

You could even create a portrait of your chosen 'superstar' using any media of your choice e.g. paints, pastels or collage.



Create a song or piece of music



Create a new song to accompany an existing backing track or write your own piece of music to play on an instrument of your choice.

You could film yourself performing your 'masterpiece' or perform it in front of the class.

Create an instrument using recycled materials

Use junk modelling to create your very own instrument. This could be something that you bang, pluck, blow or shake.



Listen, appreciate and create!



Listen to your favourite piece of music and create a piece of artwork or creative writing to represent how it makes you feel. Be as creative as you like e.g. using paints, pastels, collage, poetry and/or story writing

This could be a song from your favourite film or a song that you like to sing along to.
