

Spelling Bee's Match the Spelling

Creating Adverbs Using the Suffix -ly (where the root word ends in 'ic' or 'al')

This is a great game to help you practise making adverbs by adding -ly to words ending in 'ic' and 'al'. This game is to be played with a partner. Before starting the game, you will need to cut out the words on the following sheet.

How to play:

1. Shuffle all the spelling cards and place them upside down on a table.
2. Take it in turns at turning over two cards. If the two cards make a -ly suffix word, place them together and say the word. You then get to keep those cards.
3. The winner is the person who has the most complete words once all the cards have been used up.
