Mummifying an Orange - Fun Science

Did you know? Even the ancient Egyptians used science! Learn how they mummified their bodies with this easy experiment. They used science to preserve the bodies and now you can see how by mummifying an orange.

You will need:

- An orange
- Knife **to be use by an adult**
- Teaspoon
- Bowl
- Kitchen roll
- Ground cinnamon
- Salt
- Bicarbonate of soda
- Bandages
- Safety pin
