Big Question – Have we advanced or regressed since ancient times?

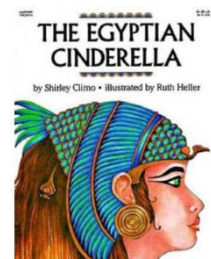

DISCOVER PROJECT

We are all set for an exciting term as we discover what life was like during the ancient Egyptian civilisation as well as the impact of the Roman occupation of Britain on modern society. Children will be asked the Big Question 'Have we advanced or regressed since ancient times?'. We will begin by looking at the chronology of Ancient Egypt and the significant moments that cemented their place in history. Later in the term, we will investigate the Egyptians achievements and see if there are any similarities to the modern world. ENGLISH

In English, we will be reading 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo. This high-quality text will support our Discover project and is a great opportunity for the children to discover and embed new vocabulary.



SCIENCE



In Science, we will be learning about states of matter. We will be investigating different materials and thinking about whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will also be observing at how temperature affects and changes a material's state.

MATHS

In maths this term we will focus on:

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Area
- Multiplication and Division



By the end of Year 4, children are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. You can support your child at home by giving them opportunities to practise their times tables, asking random times tables questions or encouraging regular sessions on TT Rock Stars. *Rapid recall* of times tables will be beneficial to support our preparations for the statutory multiplication check, which Year 4 children across the country will take between the end of May and the beginning of June. We recommend the Soundcheck game on TT Rock Stars which replicates the check, so children know exactly what to expect.

PE



PE will take place on Monday and Friday afternoons with and will be focused on basketball and gymnastics this term. Children should continue to come into school in their correct school PE uniforms on these days. Please ensure that long hair is tied back and that children are not wearing any jewellery (including earrings) on PE days.
